A new glass studio in an unusual venue invites you to take up the hottest hobby around.



Glassblowing has been around for over 2,000 years. Historians believe that it started in the Middle East. Now you can sit and watch the artisans manipulate liquid glass into stunning pieces or take classes and learn glassblowing in Shreveport. Eric Hess discovered that no glass works existed between Dallas and New Orleans. He decided to open a studio where you can learn glassblowing and create your own masterpieces. After a brief hiatus, Sanctuary Glass Studio reopened in The Agora Borealis.





Glass for sale

You can find many sculptures, bowls, glasses and more available for sale as you walk in the doors. They also accept commissions.

Create your own art

You will work with a Sanctuary artist to create your own piece of glass art. Depending on the item, you will add color to the glass, melt it, and manipulate it into a finished piece.

Currently you can create your own cup, bowl or paperweight. Other future ideas include pumpkins, Christmas ornaments or paperweights. During hummingbird season, blow your own hummingbird feeder! Check their website for COVID-19 protocols. Usually, the create your own classes happen on Friday and Saturdays.
